Each of the discipline areas provides free professional and peer **tutoring** to FCCJ students on a walk in basis. Students may stay as long as they wish. **Study sheets** and/or **learning packets** are available for students to use in the lab or take home. Lab coordinators hold related **seminars and workshops** during the term to meet students’ needs.
