North Campus and Nassau Center faculty and staff provide students with a full selection of courses and programs. We also provide onsite customized training and short-term training in many business and computer courses.

**Associates of Arts Degree (AA)** — Designed for students who plan to complete their freshman and sophomore years of college work at Florida Community College and then transfer as a junior to a four-year college or university. Students in this program primarily take general education requirements including English, Mathematics, Humanities, Natural and Physical Sciences, and Social Environment courses, such as History and Political Science.

**Associate of Science Degrees or Associate of Applied Science Degrees (AS/AAS)** — These are career and technical education programs designed to allow students to immediately pursue careers that require a college degree at the technical level. Students in these programs take at least 15 hours of general education courses, with the majority of their coursework taken in technical courses related to their major.

**Technical Certificates** — The technical certificate prepares students for entry-level work through a series of courses. Unlike the A.S./A.A.S. programs, which include liberal arts and science courses (like English and Biology), technical certificate programs are comprised mainly of courses related directly to the career the student is training for, with only a few or no liberal arts courses. A technical certificate can be completed in about half the time of an A.S./A.A.S. degree.

**Workforce Credit Certificates** — These programs are non-college credit programs for career areas that do not include liberal arts and science courses. Every class is directly related to learning skills for the career you've chosen. The programs vary in length, from a few months to two years, and range from health care to criminal justice.
