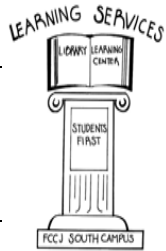

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Indefinite articles and corresponding ein-word: mein

(ein-words take the same case endings as the indefinite article ein)

	NOMINATIVE (Subject Case)	ACCUSATIVE (Direct Object)	DATIVE (Indirect Object)	GENITIVE (Possessive Case)
masculine	ein mein	einen meinen	einem meinem	eines meines (plus s on noun)
feminine	eine meine	eine meine	einer meiner	einer meiner
neuter	ein mein	ein mein	einem meinem	eines meines (plus s on noun)
plural (all genders)	meine	meine	meinen (plus n on noun)	meiner
