General Education Notes:

- Please review the Florida Community College Catalog for General Education Requirements (GER).
- CLAST (College Level Academic Skills Test): The CLAST is a graduation requirement for the bachelor's degree in the state university system of Florida. Passing all four subsets of the CLAST exam, or satisfying a CLAST exemption, is a requirement for meeting the bachelor's degree graduation requirement. Students are encouraged to take and pass the CLAST while at the community college.
- Foreign Language Requirement: Students who have not completed two years of sequential foreign language study or American Sign Language in high school must complete 8 hours of college level foreign language or American Sign Language at FCCJ. This requirement must be completed at FCCJ, prior to admission to FAMU.
- All General Education courses require a grade of "C" or above.

Prerequisite and Elective Notes:

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of "C" or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both FCCJ General Education Requirements and FAMU Major Prerequisites. Please review the General Education Requirements and talk with an advisor.
- Professional Electives to be chosen from an approved list in FCCJ Catalog
- ARH 2050, Art History I at FCCJ shall be substituted for ARC 2701 Architectural History I, a Humanities elective and required major course at FAMU.
- A combination of ETG 2502 Engineering Mechanics, and ETG 2530 Text and Strength of Materials at FCCJ shall be substituted for ARC 2501 Architectural Structures I at FAMU.
- It is recommended that a student complete the FCCJ elective, IND 2310 Graphic Presentation Techniques. This course and TAR 2120 Architectural Drafting shall be used to satisfy the presentation requirements of ARC 2303 Architectural D 2.1 at FAMU.

Other Notes:

- The FAMU Architectural Studies program is a limited access program. Please contact FAMU for more information about the application process.
- Qualified students will have completed a minimum of 60 semester hours before transferring.
- Students who complete their FCCJ course work under the terms of the catalog in effect during the term of their registration must graduate within five years or they will automatically be reassigned to the catalog in effect during their fifth year.
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.
