Other Notes:

- Qualified students will have earned a grade point average of **2.0** and will have completed the AS Criminal Justice Officer Technology degree (a minimum of 64 semester hours) before transferring.
- No fewer than 60 hours semester hours of credit from the AS degree may be transferred toward completion of the degree requirements at APUS.
- Courses in which students have earned a grade of “C” or higher will be accepted for transfer. APUS acknowledges that Florida State College at Jacksonville’s forgiveness policy allows students to repeat a course in an attempt to improve the grade. Students should follow the Florida State College at Jacksonville forgiveness policy. APUS calculates GPAs for all transfer students using the last grade earned for each course attempted.
- All associate degree seeking students must demonstrate mastery of the Information Literacy Assessment (effective for students entering fall term 2004) as a graduation requirement. Refer to the assessment section of the College catalog for details.
- Students who complete their Florida State College at Jacksonville course work under the terms of the catalog in effect during the term of their registration must graduate within five years or they will automatically be reassigned to the catalog in effect during their fifth year.
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.
